Amendment of Section 2706-4
Title 22, California Code of Regulations

AMEND SECTION 2706-4 TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

§ 2706-4. ~~Claims~~ Claim Documents That May Be Filed by Mail.

- a) ~~All claims and other required documents relating thereto~~ required claim documents completed by the claimant or their authorized representative may be filed by mail except in those cases where the claimant is notified by the department that a personal appearance or examination will be required. Filing by mail shall be deemed complete at the time of deposit in the mail, in a sealed envelope, with postage paid, addressed to the department.
- b) Physicians and practitioners must file documents electronically through the department's online system unless they have requested and been granted a waiver. The department may grant the waiver when the physician or practitioner has established to the satisfaction of the director that there is a lack of automation, a severe economic hardship, or other good cause. An approved waiver shall be valid for one year or longer, at the discretion of the director.
